Terms and Conditions

OVERVIEW

To celebrate the best of Motion Graphics and Animation from Australia and New Zealand, TheNode presents a LOGO IDENT ANIMATION competition. Participants submit a 15-30 second animated ident. Prizes are available in two categories, professionals and students.

Submission dates:

Submissions open August 10, 2023 and close midnight AEST October 1, 2023

Entries:

Submissions are made online via: <https://www.thenode.is/idents>

Eligibility:

Only Australian and New Zealand residents may enter TheNode Ident Competition and be eligible for the major prizes.

Students, Professionals, Teams and Studios from Australia and New Zealand may enter.

You may enter as many times as you like.

There is no fee to enter.

Participants:

Participation is voluntary. All participants must register an entry through TheNode website in order to submit an entry.

Submissions:

All submissions are subject to approval. TheNode directors reserve the right to disapprove any

submissions that don't adhere to the set criteria or are deemed inappropriate for any reason.

Rights:

The Entrant warrants to TheNode that the submission does not infringe on any rights, including copyright and third party, and that the Entrant has obtained all necessary releases and permissions to enter the submission.

We confirm that you have granted TheNode the right to publicly exhibit your ident and that TheNode will take all care but no responsibility for your ident while in the possession of the Festival. We also confirm that if accepted into the festival, you grant TheNode the right to publicly promote your ident in all festival promotional materials, as appropriate.

Technical:

- Entries may use any form of video or animation techniques whether analog or digital.
- The preferred format is 1920 x 1080 (16 x 9)
- All video submissions must be in MP4 format and no larger than 100Mb in file size.
- All video submissions must also include a thumbnail image of the entry in .jpg or .png format. This file must be no larger than 1Mb in file size.
- Video(s) may not be less than a minimum length of 15 seconds.
- Video(s) may not exceed a maximum length of 30 seconds.

Judging:

A single winner in each category will be announced at TheNode on November 4 2023.

Judging will be based on votes from TheNode Ident Judges.

Judges' decisions are final.
